Key Findings

Nearly 7.5% of mining's workforce is Indigenous, compared to 3.9% of Canada's workforce

Job openings in mining grew substantially, from 785 vacancies in Q4 2016 to 2,650 vacancies in Q2 of 2019

Employment in mining has grown each year since 2015
