The **Canadian Mining Certification Program (CMCP)** is the industry-standard for confirming your skills, knowledge, and experience in the mining sector.

The CMCP helps you be recognized as:

Why get certified?

- Confirms the value of your experience
- Provides potential to advance your career
- Recognizes your knowledge, training, and skills
- Improves your standing as a potential recruit
- Shows your commitment to safety to your team
- Demonstrates your pride in being a mining professional



Who can get certified?

Certification is available for the following mining occupations:

- Diamond Drillers
- Frontline Supervisors
- Hoist Operators
- Industry Trainers
- Mineral Processing Operators
- Surface Miners
- Underground Miners

What are the levels of certification?

Level 1 confirms you have the fundamental training required and a minimum number of hours on the job, demonstrating your ability to apply skills and knowledge in the workplace.

Level 2 in addition to level one requirements, confirms you have acquired additional hours and the specialized skills and knowledge to efficiently perform a specific occupation without supervision.

What is involved?

- Gathering documentation and training records
- Validating skills, knowledge, and experience
- Completing forms/documentation



How do you become certified?

Method 1: Workplace Assessor

MiHR designated sites are actively engaged in the CMCP and have trained Workplace Assessors (WPA) onsite to assess your skills, knowledge and experience.

Method 2: Examiner Panel

Document and assess your own skills, knowledge, and experience, and provide three professional referee references, all of which is evaluated by an Examiner Panel.
