Workplace sexual harassment can be traumatizing for individuals, whether involved directly or indirectly. People also experience a number of barriers to reporting. To avoid a culture of silence, protect against a poisoned work environment and help create a positive reporting environment, learn about workplace supports for reporting.

The following may be available in your workplace:

- Policy and procedure
- People health and safety, union, hr, supervisor or alternate if they are harassing you
- Reporting forms, hotlines, incident reports
- Mediation offered as an alternative to a formal complaint
- Investigation of complaints and sharing of results to parties involved
- Training
- Information on when confidentiality is available
- Counselling
